Other Dates in MCF History

- ◆ **In 1970**, your community foundation established as the Marshall Civic Foundation
- ◆ **In 1986**, the Foundation received its first major gift/bequest of \$112,000 from the Ethel Markham estate
- ◆ **In 1991**, the Foundation name changed to the Marshall Community Foundation
 - James Cooke hired as 1st Executive Director
 - Eaton Corporation gave a \$25,000 grant
 - Established an office courtesy of Michigan National Bank
 - Office furnishings courtesy of State Farm Insurance
- ◆ **In 1992**, W. K. Kellogg Foundation awards a \$50,000 grant
 - The “Fund for Marshall” Campaign Drive
 - The Youth Advisory Council (YAC) created
 - Julie Ousley named as 1st YAC Advisor
- ◆ **In 1993**, Judge John Brundage appointed as the Marshall Tomorrow Chair
 - Sandra Dobbins hired as 2nd Executive Director
 - Foundation received an anonymous gift of \$1M
- ◆ **In 1995**, Sandra Dobbins named as 2nd YAC Advisor
- ◆ **In 1996**, The “Fund for Marshall” Campaign attained its goal of \$2 M
 - W.K. Kellogg Foundation granted a \$1 M match
- ◆ **In 2000**, Sherry Anderson hired as 3rd Executive Director
- ◆ **In 2002**, Morris Stulberg stepped down as the Board President after 32 years
 - Trustee Charles Cook appointed as Board President
- ◆ **In 2010**, Foundation celebrated 40th Anniversary
- ◆ **In 2011**, Foundation Boardroom Dedication honoring founder, Morris Stulberg
- ◆ **In 2012**, Foundation relocated to new offices on Homer Rd.
- ◆ **In 2015**, Shannon Tiernan hired as 4th Executive Director
- ◆ **In 2016**, Kate Stewart hired as 3rd YAC Advisor
