

K. John Lord Engineering and Science Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: Scholarships awarded to Marshall High School graduating seniors or previous MHS graduates pursuing a career in the field of engineering or the sciences. Applicants must attend a two- or four-year institution as a full-time student. Preference may be given to applicants demonstrating financial need, but GPA is not a determining factor. Students who receive this scholarship are encouraged to apply for further support in subsequent years.

Essay Questions: Why are you pursuing a career in engineering and/or science and what do you hope to achieve by obtaining a degree in your chosen field?

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from a **recent** school educator/administrator and one from an adult member of the community (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: *Yes, complete the Marshall Community Foundation Financial Information form (available to download from the MCF website) and return, along with the first page only of your FAFSA Student Aid Report, with scholarship application.*

Application Process: Return the completed Marshall Community Foundation **4-page application** (available to download from the MCF website), including recommendation letter(s), essay question(s), transcripts and any other qualifying criteria to: Marshall Community Foundation, 614 Homer Road, Marshall, MI 49068.
