

Beatrice Williams Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: Scholarships awarded to Marshall High School graduating seniors pursuing a degree in the field of elementary education or early childhood development at a two- or four-year institution as a full-time student. GPA is not a determining factor.

Essay Questions: 1) Why have you chosen a career in the field of elementary or early childhood education as your goal? Include information regarding your experience working with children. Childcare, playground supervision and assisting in an elementary classroom as a volunteer are experiences to draw upon.

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from a school educator/administrator and one from an adult member of the community (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: Not required

Application Process: Return the completed Marshall Community Foundation **4-page application** (*available to download from the MCF website*), including recommendation letter(s), essay question(s), transcripts and any other qualifying criteria to: Marshall Community Foundation, 614 Homer Road, Marshall, MI 49068.
