Rolland J. and Dorothea R. Face Family Christian Ministry Service College Scholarship was established to provide scholarships for students who have received Jesus Christ as his/her Savior and are in good standing as a member of a local Christian church. Applicants must plan to pursue a full time career as a Minister of the Gospel of Jesus Christ or other full time ministry and show proof of enrollment to the following Christian Colleges: Cornerstone University, Springfield Bible Baptist College, Moody Bible Institute, Northland Baptist College, Pensacola Christian College and/or any additional Christian Colleges approved by the committee. Preference may be given to applicants with residency in Calhoun County, MI and the surrounding area. Financial information is requested, but not necessarily a determining factor. Students who receive this scholarship are encouraged to apply for further support in subsequent years.

Essay Questions: Your responses should be no more than three (3) double-spaced pages.

- Essay question for first-time applicants:
 - When did you become a Christian and how did that take place?
 - Why have you chosen to pursue an education in Christian Ministry?
- Essay question for previous recipients:
 - How have your most recent classes or experiences influenced your faith and your desire to pursue an education in Christian Ministry?

Recommendation Letters: Two required- Please provide one recommendation letter from your pastor and one from a mentor (not a family member).

- The scholarship may be granted within 12 months after awarded and is disbursed directly to the educational institution.
- The number of recipients and the amount of the award(s) will be determined annually.
- Recipients are responsible for knowledge of tax regulations regarding scholarships.

Applications are due by or must be postmarked no later than March 1

The following suggestions will assist you in completing your best grant application.

1. Make a copy of the application and complete a draft before writing on the original application.
2. Respond to every question. Write N/A (not applicable) if it does not apply to you.
3. Include all supporting documentation requested. If you are unable to include the information requested, please explain why.
4. When you write about your personal ambitions and goals, provide enough information so that the Scholarship Committee clearly understands your plans and can recognize your potential.
5. **If you do not type your responses, be sure that your handwriting is legible.**
6. Double check your spelling.
7. Ask someone to proofread the application.
8. Make a copy of the completed application and attachments and keep in a safe place.
