



## MARSHALL MUSIC FUND For Educators

The **Marshall Music Fund** was established at the Marshall Community Foundation in memory of Tony Elms to promote music programming in Marshall Public Schools. Mr. Elms loved and respected all kinds of music. Mr. Elms' family and friends established the **Marshall Music Fund** so that Mr. Elms would always be remembered.

The Marshall Music Fund is for Educators in the Marshall Public Schools seeking to enhance Music Programs for 5<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. All music fields, including instrumental and vocal, are eligible to apply. Funding supports programming up to one year.

Grants awarded to educators will vary with the program relative to the educators' proposals, the funds available for distribution and at the discretion of the Marshall Community Foundation's Board of Trustees. **The funds awarded will be directed to the Marshall Public Schools.**

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***The grant application packet should not exceed 5 pages and must include the following:***

General overview - project description - itemized budget – recommendation letters

Note: Proposal must be accompanied by 2 recommendation letters...one from the Superintendent and one from a member in the community (a person not employed by the school system)
