

Peter C. Stuart Journalism Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: *A scholarship awarded in **ODD** numbered years to a Marshall High School graduating senior or former graduate pursuing a career in journalism or a clearly related curriculum at a four-year institution. Applicants must maintain passing grades for the year of the scholarship. Students who receive this scholarship may apply for further support in subsequent years.*

Essay Question: Prepare a short essay on the impact of the electronic media upon the written media and how the principle of truthful and accurate reporting can be maintained. (The significant change in publication of the Monitor from all print to a combination of print and electronic media is a good example of the change which has taken place.)

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from a current school educator/administrator or professor and one from an adult member of the community (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: *Yes, please obtain and complete Marshall Community Foundation financial information form and return, along with the first page only of your FAFSA Student Aid Report, with scholarship application.*

Application Process: Return the completed Marshall Community Foundation **4-page application**, including recommendation letter(s), essay question(s), transcripts and any other qualifying criteria to: Marshall Community Foundation, 614 Homer Road, Marshall, MI 49068.
