Description/ Qualifying Criteria: *A scholarship awarded to a Marshall High School graduating senior pursuing a career in criminal justice/law enforcement or the medical field at a two- or four-year institution. A minimum GPA is not required; however transcripts and test scores are required.*

Essay Question: 1) Please explain in 250 words or less why you want to pursue your chosen career. 2) In addition to the first essay question, choose **two** of the following to respond to:

- a. Choose a meaningful experience and describe how it relates to your chosen career and your goals for the future.
- b. Choose a person or persons you admire and explain why.
- c. Describe how you have demonstrated leadership in your school and community.
- d. What special qualities do you think a person in your chosen career should have?

Recommendation Letters: One required from a school educator/administrator.

Financial Criteria: Not required
