

Marilyn Paskett Memorial Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: *A scholarship awarded to a Marshall High School graduating senior pursuing a degree in the teaching profession (elementary or secondary) while attending any four-year institution on a part- or full-time basis. Applicants must provide a list of community and school activities and a job history. Financial information is requested, but not necessarily a determining factor. A minimum 2.0 GPA is required.*

Essay Questions: 1) Why have you chosen the teaching profession as your goal? 2) Why do you feel it is important to be involved in extra curricular activities and how have they impacted your life?

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from a school educator/administrator and one from an employer or an adult member of the community (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: *Yes, complete the Marshall Community Foundation Financial Information form (available to download from the MCF website) and return, along with the first page only of your FAFSA Student Aid Report, with scholarship application.*

Application Process: Return the completed Marshall Community Foundation **4-page application** (available to download from the MCF website), including recommendation letter(s), essay question(s), transcripts and any other qualifying criteria to: Marshall Community Foundation, 614 Homer Road, Marshall, MI 49068.
