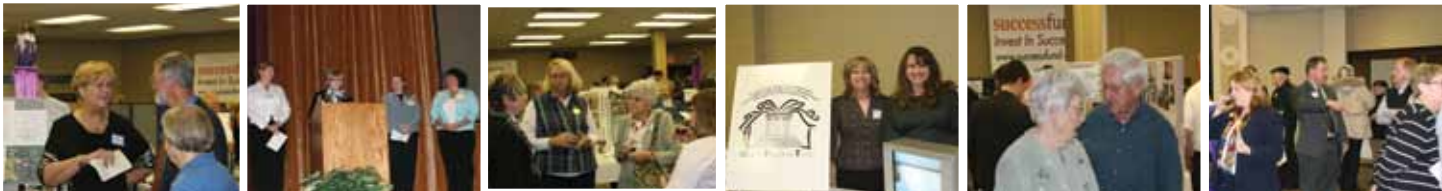
## Tax Advantages

When giving to your Community Foundation, your gift may qualify for a Federal deduction and a Michigan State Tax credit. Contact the Foundation for more information or consult with your tax advisor.

- You must be at least 70 1/2 years of age at the time of the gift.
- The gift (maximum: \$100,000) must be an outright gift, not a planned or deferred gift.
- The amount you give must otherwise be taxable if distributed directly to you.
- Gifts to Donor Advised Funds, Supporting Organizations or Private Foundations are not eligible.
- This special gift does not affect the deductibility of other contributions.
