

Kevin and Kara Wills Family Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: *A scholarship awarded to a Marshall High School or Marshall Opportunity High School graduating senior or previous graduate, including those currently attending a community college for one or more semesters. Applicants must prove enrollment to Eastern Michigan University or the University of Michigan. Financial information is requested but not necessarily a determining factor. The scholarship is renewable for one additional year to a previous recipient who maintains a status in good standing.*

Essay Questions: 1) What is your chosen field of study and how will college help prepare you to achieve your career goals? 2) Why have you chosen to continue your education at Eastern Michigan University or the University of Michigan? 3) Identify one of your special qualities, describing why it differentiates you as a candidate to receive this scholarship.

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from a **recent** school educator/administrator and one from an adult member of the community (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: *Yes, complete the Marshall Community Foundation Financial Information form (available to download from the MCF website) and return, along with the first page only of your FAFSA Student Aid Report, with scholarship application.*

Application Process: Return the completed Marshall Community Foundation **4-page application** (available to download from the MCF website), including recommendation letter(s), essay question(s), transcripts and any other qualifying criteria to: Marshall Community Foundation, 614 Homer Road, Marshall, MI 49068.
