

Marshall Rotary Club Gauss Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: *Scholarships awarded annually to Marshall High School graduating seniors or graduating seniors who are residents of Marshall, MI. Applicants must plan to attend a two- or four-year undergraduate college as a full time student. Financial need, involvement in community service activities, co- and extra-curricular activities and GPA may all be determining factors.*

Rotary Mission Statement: The mission of Rotary International is to provide service to others, promote integrity, and advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace through its fellowship of business, professional, and community leaders.

Essay Questions: Write a personal statement including how you are living in a way that reflects the mission of Rotary International.

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from a school educator, administrator or someone associated with the school such as, but not limited to, a coach, and the other from a Marshall Rotary Club member who is not a family member.

Financial Criteria: *Yes, complete the Marshall Community Foundation Financial Information form (available to download from the MCF website) and return, along with the first page only of your FAFSA Student Aid Report, with scholarship application.*

Application Process: Return the completed Marshall Community Foundation **4-page application** (available to download from the MCF website), including recommendation letter(s), essay question(s), transcripts and any other qualifying criteria to: Marshall Community Foundation, 614 Homer Road, Marshall, MI 49068.
